## HSC 2014 Results

Once again Mount St Benedict College produced an excellent set of results in the Higher School Certificate.

Congratulations and well done to the students for their hard work, the parents for their support and the professionalism of the teachers.

Congratulations to Emma Hayman, Chloe Saker, Jessica Smith and Zaira Rocchi who received a mention on the All Rounder List. This list acknowledges students who achieved a Band 6 (or its equivalent) in ten of their HSC units [including English].

Congratulations to Chloe Saker for receiving a mention on the Top Achievers List for Ancient History (Top 10 place in the respective course).

This year the College had 131 mentions on the Distinguished Achievers List. This list acknowledges students who achieved a Band 6 or its equivalent in the respective courses.

In 31 of the 36 courses attempted the mean examination mark for the College was higher than the State's mean and in 61% of these courses the mean was at least 5 marks higher than the State's mean.

It is estimated that 36% of the eligible cohort, of 105 students, achieved an ATAR over 90, 69% achieved an ATAR over 80 and 89% achieved an ATAR over 70.
